FACTS **What does The Alliance Development Fund, Inc. do with your personal information?**

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Information we receive from you on applications, voluntary surveys, and other forms.
- Information about your transactions with us.
- Information we receive from The Christian and Missionary Alliance.
- Information from search companies in the event we have lost contact with you.

How? All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons The Alliance Development Fund, Inc. chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - affiliates from using your information to market to you - sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional right to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Christian and Missionary Alliance - The Orchard Foundation - Shell Point Retirement Community
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - GoldStar Trust Company (IRA & ESA Accounts only)
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - N/A
